- Q: Is The Capello Foundation a Non-profit Foundation?
- A: The Capello Foundation is a Non-profit Corporation registered with the Secretary of State of California #2226810.
- **Q:** Where do the funds for Scholarships come from?
- A: Funds come from donations by individuals and companies in our community.
- Q: Are any of my association dues used for scholarships?
- A: None of your dues are used for scholarships.
- **Q:** How are the funds raised used?
- A: When possible all the funds raised are placed in an endowment and the earnings from the endowment are used for Scholarships.
- **Q:** How are the expenses of the foundation met?
- A: Businesses and individuals are asked to sponsor the foundation's expenses.
- Q: Who may receive a scholarship?
- A: Any student graduating or who has graduated from a San Juan Unified School District high school. Also any student whose parent is a member of an employee group that is recognized by The Capello Foundation board of directors.
- Q: Which groups are currently recognized by the Capello Board of Directors?

A: There are currently two groups; The San Juan Teachers Association The San Juan Administrators Association.

- Q: How do I get an application?
- A: Applications are available from our website, www.capello.org between January 01 and the second Friday in April.
- **Q:** Where do I submit the completed application?
- A: Applications should only be sent to the address listed on the application.
- Q: How much are the scholarships for?
- A: There is one scholarship in the memory of Pam Capello that is for \$1000.00 and the rest for that year are based on the funds available and the number of applicants remaining.
- Q: When and how are the Scholarships announced?
- A: In late May of each year awardees are initially notified by E-mail. They will receive the award at each San Juan District High School awards assembly.
- Q: Who determines who will receive an award?
- A: A Special ad-hoc Committee makes the determination with a recommendation to the Capello Board of Directors.
- **Q:** Who has the final say on the awarding of Scholarships?
- A: The Capello Board of Directors is the final authority.
