

MULTI MEDIA S.I.G. – DVD INSTRUCTIONS USING ROXIO BUILDER VER7

1. Select a menu from Theme on the left side bar under DVD MENU settings
2. Doesn't really matter, if you will later change the background scene, just be sure your choice has a music note on the right hand lower corner. Return to the Home Window of DVD builder
3. Select Add Title. It's easiest if you choose a still image. You will be in the Add Media To Project Window. Which really points back to your computer. Choose a picture file. Click on ADD.

A storyboard pane will automatically appear on the lower BOTTOM half of the screen. Click on the icon from the lower middle toolbar labeled "Advanced Edit".

Tip : hover the mouse across the picture that looks like a Hollywood directors clapboard.

Be patient . A program called StoryBoard7.exe is loading. A new window appears

4. Click on the Browse folders on your computer icon (which points you to your computer) . It will be the obvious yellow folder icon . Once here, you can CLICK on the window on the upper window pane labeled " Media Selector Folders". This window is actually your version of Windows Explorer. You can change to any folder media of your choice on your computer from here.
5. Click on the Medial Selector Folder Window, change it to your my Videos folder. Choose an mpeg movie to Drop and Drag to the Story line.
6. TRANSITIONS. Are on the same toolbar as the Media Selector Folder. You will see a square picture with at two-toned colored button to it. This is the Transitions tool. And along on this same toolbar you will also find the ABC icon, which represents adding TEXT to the item selected on the Storyline.
7. Click on DONE. When you've added all the transitions and/ or TEXT (ABC) to your selected items.
8. Back to the main screen. Here you will see the screen split into 3 parts. The left side are the tools, the rest of the screen is split in two pieces. Upper and Lower. So in reality you are looking at 3 individual window screens , each with their own tools.
9. Lastly, to change the menu music and background picture, do the following. From the main window choose DVD Menu Settings
10. Click on Advanced to get to the Menu Theme Screen, that has the settings for background picture, background music, and select fonts for the menus. In each case, click on Browse to find your choice of files for picture background and music background.
11. Remember to click on OK to set your choices!
12. Preview You Work Before Burning Be patient and watch the whole thing for flaws before hitting that burn button
13. When you do hit the BURN BUTTON..... Choose to save an ISO file . Give it a memorable name so you can re-create the whole DVD movie next time without having to go again through this long burning process which could take up to 90 minutes.
